Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

Q - How do I know what team to try out for?

A – The Super Y-league age group is different from the Canadian age group system. Please review the chart below to determine which team(s) you are eligible to try out for.

Team	Born on or after
U13	August 1 st , 1994
U14	August 1 st , 1993

Q – What is the difference between and ‘open’ and ‘closed’ evaluation?

A – Open evaluations are available for any interested and eligible player to attend. Closed Evaluations are often called invitational evaluations, and players are invited, or asked, to attend an upcoming evaluation.

Q – Is there any cost to attend an evaluation?

A – Yes. There is a one time, \$10.00 fee to attend the evaluations. Players will pay the fee, in cash, at the first evaluation that they attend and that will cover all subsequent evaluations.

Q – Is there any cost to join the team?

A – Yes. Surrey WFC and all other Super Y-league affiliates operate on a cost recovery model. This means that players will be charged based on the cost of the program.

Q – What is the open house for?

A – The Surrey WFC open house is designed for players and parents to come and meet the coaches and other people involved. There is an opportunity to have questions answered and get important information about the evaluations and team programs for the upcoming season.

Q – How will I know if I made the team?

A – Team rosters will be finalized on April 11th and phone calls will be made. All players who attend the last closed evaluation will be contacted, by telephone, and told whether they have, or have not, been selected to the team. Players who are offered a spot on the team must immediately accept or decline the opportunity. Final rosters will be published at www.surreywfc.com.

Q – What happens at the team meeting?

A – This is an opportunity for players to meet their team mates and coaches. There will be some program information and administrative items on the agenda. More information will be released at the closed evaluations.

Q – Where are the fields located?

A – Most, if not all, on field activity for Surrey WFC will occur at one of the following locations.
